Narrative Description of Our Activities

HISTORY: The Sand Springs Community Theatre was officially established in May of 2007 after receiving a grant through the city of Sand Springs. The original committee consisted of only a handful of dedicated people who envisioned dramatic arts as a key component in the growth and renewal of our city. We wanted to provide an outlet for our community members to literally “play a part” in this exciting endeavor. We became incorporated June 26th, 2007 and began production. Our first official meeting was held in July 2007. We produced The Sunshine Boys in Nov 2007, Christmas Crackups Dec, 2007 Who Will Sing For Lena Feb., 2008 And ended our first season with Arsenic and Old Lace May, 2008.
